Match Format:

- Each match comprises seven rubbers played in two sessions; each rubber being best-of-three 13-point level-play games, played to the rules for national competitions as stipulated by Croquet England before the start of the season.
- In the first session, both teams' players A and B play doubles, and player C from each team plays singles against player D from the other team.
- In the second session, all four players play singles against their opposite numbers.
- Where ample playing facilities are available, either or both sessions may be extended to best-of-three 19-point games with the agreement of both team captains.
